

# If Truly Led by the Holy Spirit, a Church Will Follow the Bible's Principles

But, if a church is led by another spirit, it will follow other principles. So consider, does the church you attend follow Bible principles about tongue-speaking:

1. Will all tongue-speakers use a known language of the world today?  
Acts 2:6,8,11
2. Does the church in that location and do all the tongue-speakers desire rather to prophesy? 1 Cor 14:5
3. Does the church and do the tongue speakers desire rather to speak five words with understanding than whole speeches with no understanding? 1 Cor 14:19
4. Are tongues used as a sign to unbelievers and not to believers?  
1 Cor 14:22
5. Do more than three persons speak in tongues in the assembly?  
1 Cor 14:27
6. Do all speak in tongues only if an interpreter is present? 1 Cor 14:28
7. Are the tongue-speakers able to hold their tongues? 1 Cor 14:32
8. Do the women keep silent in the assembly or are women preachers permitted? 1 Cor 14:34
9. Did every tongue-speaker receive the gift by the laying on of the apostle's hands? Acts 8-14-24

The Holy Spirit promised that after the New Testament was fully revealed and confirmed then there would be no longer speaking in tongues needed, 1 Corinthians 13:8-10. If led by the Spirit, a church will follow the Spirit's directions.
