

## How Great Is God

God is the only One. Following are passages about God's oneness<sup>1</sup>. Note that these passages show that He is without peer, that no one is like Him:

1. "... there is no one like Yahweh our God." Exodus 8:10
2. "Yahweh, He is God; there is no other besides Him." Deuteronomy 4:35
3. "Yahweh, He is God in heaven above and on the earth below; there is no other." Deuteronomy 4:39
4. "See now that I, I am He, And there is no god besides Me" Deuteronomy 32:39
5. "Hear, O Israel! Yahweh is our God, Yahweh is one [echad]!" Deuteronomy 6:4 [[Importantly, "Echad", denoting a unified one in the OT is translated only by Greek word "hen" in the NT: for example, the two married persons become one (echad) flesh and as Jesus describes this in Greek in NT He says one (hen).]]
6. "You are great, O Lord God; for there is none like You, and there is no God besides You" 2 Samuel 7:22
7. "For who is God, besides Yahweh? And who is a rock, besides our God?" 2 Samuel 22:32
8. "Yahweh is God; there is no one else." 1 Kings 8:60
9. "You are the God, You alone [Hebrew "bad" an absolute numeric one], of all the kingdoms of the earth." 2 Kings 19:15
10. "O Lord, there is none like You, nor is there any God besides You" 1 Chronicles 17:20
11. "You alone [bad] are Yahweh." Nehemiah 9:6
12. "For who is God, but Yahweh? And who is a rock, except our God" Psalm 18:31
13. "You alone [bad], Lord, are God." Isaiah 37:20
14. "Before Me there was no God formed, And there will be none after Me." Isaiah 43:10 "the only Saviour" Isa 43:11
15. "'I am the first and I am the last, And there is no God (plural noun "Elohim") besides Me." Isaiah 44:6
16. "Is there any God besides Me, Or is there any *other* Rock? I know of none." Isaiah 44:8
17. "I (singular) am Yahweh, and there is no other; Besides Me there is no God (plural noun Elohim)." Isaiah 45:5
18. "Surely, God is with you, and there is none else, No other God." Isaiah 45:14
19. "I am Yahweh, and there is none else." Isaiah 45:18
20. "Is it not I, Yahweh? And there is no other God besides Me, A righteous God and a Savior; There is none except Me." Isaiah 45:21
21. "I am God, and there is no other; *I am* God, and there is no one like Me" Isaiah 46:9

<sup>1</sup> Notice that two Hebrew and two Greek words are used for translated word "one." These can denote a unified one as in Deut 6:4 compared to Gen 2:24 or an absolute numeric one as in Isaiah 37:20. The scripture shows that the Father, the Son, the Holy Spirit are God. And, God is one. This is consistent throughout scripture. Hence, Gen 1:26: 3:22:11:7, the pronoun "Us" is used about God and the plural Hebrew noun "Elohim" translated "God."

22. "And Yahweh will be king over all the earth; in that day Yahweh will be *the only one* [echad], and His name *the only one*[echad]." Zechariah 14:9
23. "No one can serve two masters; for either he will hate the one [hen] and love the other, or he will be devoted to one [hen] and despise the other. You cannot serve God and wealth." Matthew 6:24
24. "But do not be called Rabbi; for One [hen] is your Teacher, and you are all brothers." Matthew 23:8
25. "Do not be called leaders; for One [hen] is your Leader, that is, Christ." Matthew 23:10
26. "'The foremost is, 'Hear, O Israel! The Lord our God is one [hen] Lord; " Mark 12:29
27. "you do not seek the glory that is from the one and only [Greek "monos" is an absolute numeric one] God?" John 5:44
28. "I and the Father are one [hen]." John 10:30
29. "This is eternal life, that they may know You, the only [monos] true God" John 17:3
30. "The glory which You have given Me I have given to them, that they may be one [hen], just as We are one [hen]" John 17:22
31. "since indeed God is one [hen]" Romans 3:30
32. "to the only [monos] wise God, Amen." Romans 16:27
33. "there is no God but one [hen]" 1 Corinthians 8:4
34. "yet for us there is *but* one [hen] God, the Father, from whom are all things and we *exist* for Him; and one [hen] Lord, Jesus Christ, by whom are all things, and we *exist* through Him." 1 Corinthians 8:6
35. "Now a mediator is not for one *party only*; whereas God is *only one* [hen]." Galatians 3:20
36. "There is one [hen] body and one [hen] Spirit, one [hen] hope, one [hen] Lord, one [hen] faith, one [hen] baptism, one [hen] God and Father of all who is over all and through all and in all." Ephesians 4:4-6
37. "Now to the King eternal, immortal, invisible, the only [monos] God" 1 Timothy 1:17
38. "which He will bring about at the proper time—He who is the blessed and only [monos] Sovereign, the King of kings and Lord of lords, who alone [monos] possesses immortality and dwells in unapproachable light, whom no man has seen or can see. To Him *be* honor and eternal dominion! Amen." 1 Timothy 6:16
39. "For there is one [hen] God, *and* one mediator also between God and men, *the man* Christ Jesus," 1 Timothy 2:5
40. "You believe that God is one [hen]. You do well; the demons also believe, and shudder." James 2:19
41. "For certain persons deny our only [monos] Master and Lord, Jesus Christ." Jude 4
42. "the only [monos] God our Savior, through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen." Jude 25
